

Virtual Wet Prep Workshop Course Fact Sheet

COURSE TITLE

- Virtual Wet Prep Workshop

DESCRIPTION

- The Virtual Wet Prep Workshop is an interactive, online course. Content covered in the course includes proper specimen collection, identification of elements seen in patients with normal findings, trichomoniasis, yeast vaginitis, and bacterial vaginosis, and quantitative reporting options.

AUDIENCE

- Clinical health care providers including MDs, NPs, PAs, RNs who perform Wet Prep Microscopy

OBJECTIVES

- Describe proper set up and magnification for the microscope.
- Describe proper collection and handling of specimens for saline/KOH wet preps.
- Identify the following in a saline/KOH wet prep: Epithelial cells, White blood cells, Red blood cells, bacteria, motile Trichomonads, Yeast pseudohyphae and buds, “Clue cells” and artifacts.
