## **COURSE TITLE**

• Virtual STI Intensive

#### **DESCRIPTION**

The Virtual STI Intensive Course is an interactive, online course. Content covered in the course
includes taking a sexual history, bacterial and viral sexually transmitted infections, HIV
prevention, vaginitis and PID, case studies, and evidence based assessment, prevention, and
management strategies. The Virtual STI Intensive requires daily attendance/participation and
intersession work to be completed by each participant.

#### **AUDIENCE**

• Clinical health care providers including MDs, NPs, PAs, RNs

#### **OBJECTIVES**

- Describe 5 elements of taking a sexual history and critique eliciting a thorough sexual history.
- 2. Describe how social determinants of health and societal systems affect sexual health.
- 3. Describe the epidemiology, symptomatology, diagnosis, and treatment modalities of gonorrhea and chlamydia.
- 4. Describe the epidemiology, symptomatology, diagnosis, and treatment modalities of vaginal infections and PID.
- 5. Describe 3 tools of the "HIV Prevention Toolbox" used to prevent HIV transmission.
- 6. Describe the epidemiology, symptomatology, diagnosis, and treatment modalities of syphilis.
- 7. Describe the epidemiology, symptomatology, diagnosis, and treatment modalities of HSV
- 8. Describe the epidemiology, symptomatology, diagnosis, and treatment modalities of HPV
- 9. Describe STI prevention tools including expedited partner therapy and DoxyPEP.
