

## Virtual STI Intensive Course Fact Sheet

### COURSE TITLE

- Virtual STI Intensive

### DESCRIPTION

- The Virtual STI Intensive Course is an interactive, online course. Content covered in the course includes taking a sexual history, bacterial and viral sexually transmitted infections, HIV prevention, vaginitis and PID, case studies, and evidence based assessment, prevention, and management strategies. The Virtual STI Intensive requires daily attendance/participation and intersession work to be completed by each participant.

### AUDIENCE

- Clinical health care providers including MDs, NPs, PAs, RNs

### OBJECTIVES

1. Describe 5 elements of taking a sexual history and critique eliciting a thorough sexual history.
2. Describe how social determinants of health and societal systems affect sexual health.
3. Describe the epidemiology, symptomatology, diagnosis, and treatment modalities of gonorrhea and chlamydia.
4. Describe the epidemiology, symptomatology, diagnosis, and treatment modalities of vaginal infections and PID.
5. Describe 3 tools of the “HIV Prevention Toolbox” used to prevent HIV transmission.
6. Describe the epidemiology, symptomatology, diagnosis, and treatment modalities of syphilis.
7. Describe the epidemiology, symptomatology, diagnosis, and treatment modalities of HSV
8. Describe the epidemiology, symptomatology, diagnosis, and treatment modalities of HPV
9. Describe STI prevention tools including expedited partner therapy and DoxyPEP.

### LENGTH

- Five half days – Monday through Friday, from 8:00 am – 12:00 pm MT each day

### MODALITY

- Virtual, Instructor-led, with breakout rooms and intersession work
